This single from Queen was written by bass player, John Deacon, and released in 1980 as part of their album of the same year, The Game. A nod to the disco style is apparent in this track, as Deacon explains how he was influenced by Chic's single, 'Good Times'. Originally, the band did not consider releasing it as a single until music mogul Michael Jackson convinced them to do just that!

Hints & Tips: Practice the syncopation in the chorus a few times so you grasp the rhythm. The left-hand sixteenth note should sound at exactly the same time as the right-hand sixteenth note.
